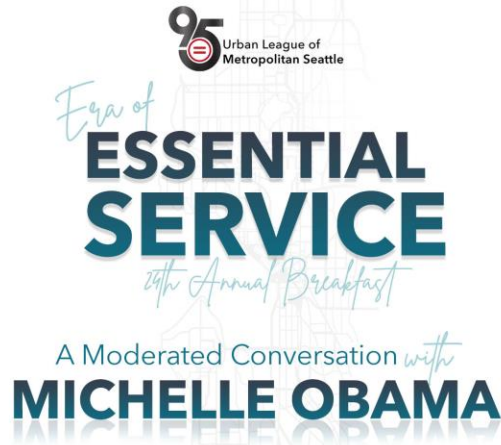
MODERATION PLAN

- We will have **one speaker timer** — this will be a countdown clock placed in front of the stage that counts down when time is left then counts up and in red when speaker goes over time.
 - In addition, we'll have **two confidence monitors** on each side of the speaker timer — one will show the live feed, and the other will show the moderator questions and any additional notes needed.
 - Finally, we will also put an **IFB** in Michelle's Merriweather's ear (*in the ear not facing the audience*). It's about the size of an air pod and very discrete. I'll be able to speak to her directly as the 10-, 5-, and 2-minute markers approach and verbally alert her as well.

IV. Moderator Candidates

Below are the proposed candidates we'd like to put forward for consideration as moderator for the keynote discussion:

Moderator: Michelle Y. Merriweather

Title: President & CEO, Urban League of Metropolitan Seattle



Biography: Since joining ULMS in 2015 and stepping into the CEO role in 2018, Michelle has transformed the organization into one of the region's most impactful civil rights institutions. Under her leadership, ULMS has expanded from a staff, significantly increasing its reach across housing, education, entrepreneurship, workforce development, health equity, and advocacy initiatives. Michelle's passion for community work is rooted in her personal mission: to build a future where Black children — including her nephew, Cayden and God Children, Olivia, Corey, and Camille— can walk tall without fear, live freely in their truth, and thrive in communities rooted in dignity, joy, and opportunity. She

brings both urgency and strategy, as well as the fighting spirit of her warrior-like grandmothers to that mission every day.

Her leadership has been recognized throughout the region. She was recognized as a Puget Sound Business Journal Woman of Influence, recognized on the Power 100 list, and received the Edwin T. Pratt Community Service Award. In addition to her role at ULMS, Michelle serves on several boards, including United Way of King County, KUOW, the Alliance for Education, and the Downtown Seattle Association. She is also a proud member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., and was appointed to the inaugural Washington State Women's Commission by Governor Jay Inslee.

Michelle holds a B.S. in Business Administration with a concentration in Marketing from Xavier University of Louisiana, the nation's only historically Black Catholic university. With heart, history, and strategy at the core of her leadership, Michelle Merriweather is moving ULMS — and the communities it serves — toward a future where equity is not a dream but a lived reality.

Back-up Moderator: Vivian Phillips

Title: Founder & Board President, [Arte Noir](#)

Biography: Vivian Phillips is a communications professional and arts leader. Her founding of ARTE NOIR in May 2021, stemmed from her decades of working with numerous local, national, and international arts organizations, artists, students of the arts, and travels to the African continent. In addition to the



online monthly publication, ARTE NOIR @ Midtown Square provides a physical space to celebrate the soulfulness and power of Black art and culture. As an arts consultant, the opportunity to lead the art plan for Midtown Square evolved into the development of the physical space, which ARTE NOIR will own and provide exposure to the richness of Black art, in perpetuity. Located in the heart of Seattle's historic Black community where Vivian was raised and where she continues to live, ARTE NOIR also fulfills another dream of creating a consistent revenue stream to Black artists through the sale of Black-created art and goods.

Vivian's professional history includes service as the Director of Communications for a Seattle Mayor, Director of Marketing and Communications for Seattle Theatre Group, restoration team Associate Director for the Paramount Theatre, Seattle University

Adjunct Professor (MFA Arts Leadership), television, radio, and live performance producing, public speaking, and numerous arts and strategic communications projects. She served as the Chair for both the Seattle Arts Commission and 4Culture, and co-founder of The Hansberry Project and the Historic Central Area Arts and Cultural District. Vivian serves as ARTE NOIR Founder and Board President and is also the co-host of the [doubleXposure Podcast](#) with Marcie Sillman exploring how culture and creativity shape our lives, while also serving on the University of Washington Foundation Board.
